Organelles found only in plant cells: the . cell wall. surrounds the outside of a plant's cell membrane, and also attaches cells to their neighbours. the wall is made of cellulose, a glucose polymer that is quite rigid. the cell wall gives plant cells shape and structure – this is why plant cells tend to have straighter sides than animal cells.
